AODA

Overview

Ontario is the first province and one of the first jurisdictions in the world to enact specific legislation establishing a goal and time-frame for accessibility. It is also the first jurisdiction to legislate accessibility reporting and to establish standards so people with disabilities can participate more actively in their communities.

The Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA) is a 2005 law that sets out a process for developing and enforcing accessibility standards. Persons with disabilities and industry representatives work together with the government to develop the standards

Accessibility standards are laws that government, businesses, non-profits and public sector organizations must follow to become more accessible.

They help organizations identify and remove barriers to improve accessibility for people with disabilities.

Monitor/track absences, occurrences and build custom support programs.



Parklane System AODA Selection


When the Parklane System is first selected the user will enter their User ID and Password.



This will open Parklane's main menu panel.




The AODA options for changing the font size and to change the program colours can be selected from the **GoTo** drop down menu on the Parklane main menu panel.




Fonts

After changing the font size, select **Close Esc** and the Parklane application will close and you may restart.




The user will now have access to the font size of their selection.




Colour
